CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

2021 SLOVENIA OPEN BEACH PARAVOLLEY - MEN & WOMEN

ParaVolley Europe is pleased to announce the staging of the 2021 Slovenia Open Beach – Men and Women.

PVE and non-PVE Member Nations “in good standing” are eligible to apply for the 2021 Slovenia Open Beach ParaVolley and are asked to fill in the Beach Teams Entry Form (attached to this Invitation) no later than **15th April 2021**. National Federations/Associations and other entities who are not, as yet, WPV members, are also encouraged to apply.

The groups are to be decided by **6th June 2021**. The PVE Sports Department reserves the right to propose the structure of the competition rounds/pools after the Team Entry Forms are received, and with a maximum of 6 teams per pool.

The last withdrawal date is **31st May 2021 (at no costs)**. Withdrawal after 31st May 2021 will incur a PVE penalty fee of € 1,000.00 which will result in the member nation not being “in good standing” until the penalty fee is paid.

Hosts:

The 2021 Slovenia Open Beach ParaVolley will be held in Ljubljana (SLO) between 27 and 29th July 2021.

Events:

Four separate events will be held during the 2021 Slovenia Open Beach ParaVolley. These will be:

- Women’s Beach ParaVolley (Standing)
- Men’s Beach ParaVolley (Standing)
- Women’s Sitting Beach Volleyball
- Men’s Sitting Beach Volleyball

It is also possible for competing teams to take part in both the Standing and Sitting events.

If a National Association/Federation/Entity would like to enter more than one team per event, these additional teams need to be registered on the Beach Teams Entry Form and will be then placed in a waiting list. Entries from this waiting list will be allocated according to available slots.



Regulations:

The competitions shall be played in accordance with the WPV Beach ParaVolley Rules 2019-2020 and the 2013-2016 World ParaVolley Beach Rules Sitting. However, teams taking part in this tournament will be allowed to register four players per team, although only 3 players can be on the court at any one time. A maximum of 1 (one) VS2 player is allowed per team.

Teams will be allowed to have a maximum of two substitutions per team per set (the replacement player may enter the game in place of one of the players of the starting line-up, and he/she can only be replaced by the same starting player). Exceptional substitutions in case of injury/illness will also be allowed.

Each team will be allowed to have a coach.

More information about the regulations related to each of these events can be found in the Specific Competition Regulations attached to this invitation (Appendix A).

Competition Days:

- Arrival day: Sunday 25th or Monday 26th July
- Departure day: Friday 30th July
- Competition days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
- Technical Meeting: Online technical meeting 1 month before event & Technical Meeting on Monday evening

Classification:

The PVE Medical Department and/or Technical Delegate reserve the right to confirm the players' class and status only by the medical documentation and "on sight" if there is an evident player's VS1 class. The class and status decided as such shall apply only to this competition. However, classification classes and statuses already issued by WPV are considered as valid and can be used by the athletes for this tournament.

All teams are asked to contact the medical department and upload player's medical documentation on PVSAS to be approved for the official competition and finish online classifications.

Team expenses:

Fees to be collected per team:

- The registration fee for participating teams is **€400.00** per team for teams taking part in one event only. Teams taking part in two events (Standing & Sitting) will pay a registration fee of **€600.00**.

- The fee mentioned above covers registration fee to PVE as well as the LOC fee.
- The LOC fee covers the organisation of the event, IT support, as well as dinner and lunch for the team members from arrival day to departure day.
- International travel, Medical insurance, visas, accommodation and team uniforms are to be covered by the participating teams.
- The LOC will be proposing a list of accommodation premises to choose from (hotels/hostels/camps). Teams will be responsible for the booking of their accommodation for the duration of the tournament.
- Host is to cover the ITO's travel costs, full Board and Accommodation for each ITO nominated (a minimum of one Technical Delegate, WPV Referee, Classifiers (if needed), Communication Official), including the costs of the competition organisation (match refreshment – water to be provided), local referees' costs, and the costs of the award (a minimum of one Participation diploma per athlete – design to be provided by PVE).

To be considered for participation, the Men's and Women's national teams must complete and return the Beach Teams Entry Form no later than 15th April 2021. All forms are to be sent to beach@paravolley.eu
