Description of Position:

The PVE Coaching Commissioner is responsible for all matters relating to ParaVolley and Beach coaches of all levels within the European Zone including the education, training and development of coaches in coordination with the WPV related Commissions, and the administration of the PVE Coaching Commission.

Reporting and Working Relationships:

The PVE Coaching Commissioner reports to the PVE Sports Director and PVE General Manager.

The PVE Coaching Commissioner may propose other members to form part of the Coaches Commission to the PVE Sports Director (if required).

The PVE Coaching Commissioner works in co-operation with the PVE Sports Director, the PVE Competitions Department, the PVE Coaches Commission members, and the ParaVolley and Beach coaches within the PVE Zone.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- *Regularly liaise and communicate with the PVE Sports Director by;*
 - *Providing advice on the education, training and development pathways for coaches in all disciplines of ParaVolley*
 - *Planning in coordination with WPV related Commissions for the education and development of coaching courses' tutors.*



- Regularly communicate with the PVE Coaching Commission members by:
 - Holding regular meetings to discuss any coaching matters
 - Seeking their advice on appropriate coaching matters
 - Providing information for their education and development.
- Addressing potential World ParaVolley rule changes and interpretations in coordination with WPV related Commission by:
 - Participating in WPV meetings related to the Coaches Commission
 - Providing information to the PVE Coaching Commission members and all coaches on potential changes to rules and interpretations
 - Providing recommendations to the PVE Sport Director.
- Keep an updated database of all Coaches within the PVE Zone
- Support the activities and involvement of coaches within the PVE Zone by liaising and communicating with them on a regular basis on coaching matters.
- Ensure proper processes are followed by complying with the constitution and policies established for the conduct of ParaVolley Europe activities.
- Undertake any other reasonable duties as requested by the PVE Sport Director.

Skills and Knowledge:

Essential:

- Must be an active ParaVolley Coach or Assistant Coach
- An advanced technical knowledge of all disciplines of ParaVolley offered by World ParaVolley
- Efficient and effective communication skills
- Working knowledge of information technology
- An understanding of the structure, processes and procedures of WPV/PVE
- A respect and appreciation of the cultural differences within the ParaVolley community
- Competencies in the English language, verbal and written.
